

Worship of God on the site dates back to 1636 with the present church building being completed in 1772. The building is a well-known landmark, with its 180-foot spire topped by a gilded cross and is fortunate to have two magnificent organs. Amongst the organists of the church was William Harty, whose son was the world famous compose and conductor, Sir Hamilton Harty Sir Hamilton's ashes are buried at the west door of the church, near a bird bath which is dedicated to his memory and a blue plaque marks
